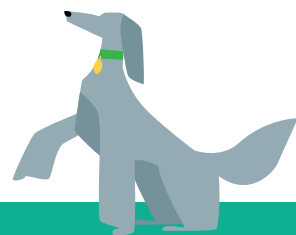
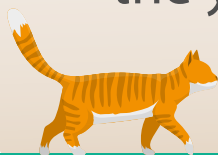

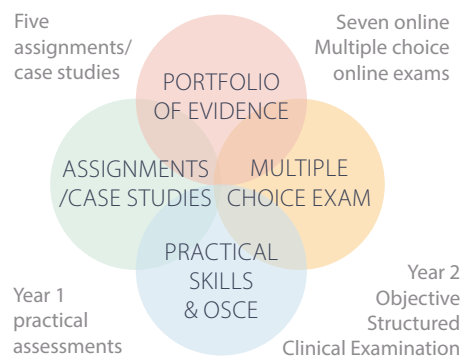
FOCUSES ON RCVS DAY-ONE SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

A programme designed to support learners in gaining the skills and underpinning knowledge relevant to the role of the registered veterinary nurse.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Students who are already employed in a veterinary practice looking to undertake this qualification must be at least 16 years of age. Non-employed students must be a minimum of 19 years of age on the 1st of the month in which the course starts. A minimum of five GCSEs at Grades A*-C (9-4) including English Language, Mathematics and a Science subject. Alternative qualifications may be acceptable.

Students will undertake a variety of assessments.
