How many branches of nursing is there?

There is two RVN qualifications, the VN or the Equine VN. Once a VN you have several options to explore and specialise in i.e. nursing the exotic patients, working in referral centres etc

How do I get into being a hydrotherapist without any qualification in animals? Is there anyone you recommend as there seems to be SO many courses online and I guess some are pretty useless to have! It's a lot of money so it's nice to have an indication of what courses are recognised in the vet world.

Hawksmoor College would be the college to contact and undergo a course with for hydrotherapy. Online courses are not recommended as the course should involve practical work.
